

CT ASA CLASS E/Rec. RULES, REGULATIONS, GUIDELINES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

ASA National Council approves E/Rec. Classification for Men's Slow Pitch.

All Rules set forth by the 2009 ASA Playing Rule Book/ Code shall apply with the following noted eligibility exceptions:

Player Eligibility – A player is eligible to compete in the ASA Class “E” program as long as he abides by the Connecticut ASA Rules & Regulations, by-laws and meets the following eligibility guidelines.

1. **ELIGIBILITY: ANY PLAYER THAT PARTICIPATED OR WAS ROSTERED FOR PARTICIPATION IN CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY (Sectionals, States, Nationals, Etc.) IN 2008 FOR A CLASS D TEAM OR HIGHER, IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN E/Rec. CLASS IN 2009.** The criteria for eligibility will be revisited at the conclusion of the 2009 season.
2. Connecticut ASA will create a player classification database based upon the 2008 Championship Play Rosters. The purpose of this list will be to enforce the E/Rec. eligibility criteria.
3. Any player who has competed in Championship Play with a Class D team or higher during the current year is not eligible.

Team Eligibility – No team will be allowed to compete in the Class E program without participating in a Connecticut ASA registered league. All players on the team must meet the player eligibility guidelines.

Men's Class E Rec. Homerun Rule – Zero Home runs allowed, Any batted ball that goes over the fence in the air shall result in a half Inning ending out.
