GOOD-the umpire clearly surpasses minimum requirements, has no major deficiencies, and requires normal or less-than-normal instruction. SATISFACTORY-the umpire requires more than normal instruction, and the performance meets minimum requirements (it may exceed expectations in some respects, but falls short in others). POOR-performance does not meet minimum requirements, and umpire requires excessive instruction. UNSATISFACTORY-umpire has not been National Tournament caliber, and should not return unless meeting all requirements listed under comments.
